IMPORTANT: Spoken promises are difficult to enforce. Ask the dealer to put all promises in writing. Keep this form.

WARRANTIES FOR THIS VEHICLE:

IMPLIED WARRANTIES ONLY

This means that the dealer does not make any specific promises to fix things that need repair when you buy the vehicle or after the time of sale. But, state law "implied warranties" may give you some rights to have the dealer take care of serious problems that were not apparent when you bought the vehicle.

WARRANTY

FULL LIMITED WARRANTY. The dealer will pay 100% of the labor and 100% of the parts for the covered systems that fail during the warranty period. Ask the dealer for a copy of the warranty document for a full explanation of warranty coverage, exclusions, and the dealer's repair obligations. Under state law, "implied warranties" may give you even more rights.

SYSTEMS COVERED:

This vehicle is sold with the statutory warranty required by New York General Business Law section 198-b. The systems covered by this warranty include:

- (a) Engine. All lubricated parts, water pump, fuel pump, manifolds, engine block, cylinder head, rotary engine housings, and flywheels.
- (b) Transmission. The transmission case, internal parts, and the torque converter.
- (c) Drive Axle. Front and rear drive axle housings and internal parts, axle shafts, propeller shafts and universal joints.
- (d) Brakes. Master cylinder, vacuum assist booster, wheel cylinders, hydraulic lines and fittings and disc brake calipers.
- (e) Radiator.
- (f) Steering. The steering gear housing and all internal parts, power steering pump, valve body, piston and rack.
- (g) Alternator, generator, starter, ignition system excluding battery.
- (h) Other, if any.

DURATION:

- 90 days or 4,000 miles - vehicles with 36,000 miles or less
- 60 days or 3,000 miles - vehicles with more than 36,000 miles but less than 80,000 miles
- 30 days or 1,000 miles - vehicles with 80,000 miles or more but no more than 100,000 miles

If the vehicle is covered by a new car warranty from its manufacturer, this warranty shall be effective for the period of time between the expiration of the manufacturer's warranty and the remaining term of this warranty, if any.

SERVICE CONTRACT. A service contract is available at an extra charge on this vehicle. Ask for details as to coverage, deductible, price, and exclusions. If you buy a service contract within 90 days of the time of sales, state law "implied warranties" may give you additional rights.

PRE PURCHASE INSPECTION: ASK THE DEALER IF YOU MAY HAVE THIS VEHICLE INSPECTED BY YOUR MECHANIC EITHER ON OR OFF THE LOT.
